Local Students

Australian Citizens, Australian PRs, NZ Citizens, and holders of Permanent Humanitarian Visas for Australia

Graduate Access Bursaries

\$5,000 one-off payment in the first year of enrolment

Number: up to 100

Eligible students must belong to one or more of the following categories: Recognition as an Indigenous Australian; Previous status as a refugee or current holder of a Humanitarian Visa; Rural or isolated background; Disadvantaged socio-economic circumstances; Disability or chronic medical condition. In addition they must have demonstrated the capacity to successfully undertake a graduate professional degree; and apply for a Commonwealth Supported Place in a professional entry graduate degree.

How to Apply and Closing Date: No bursary application is required. All students accepted into the Graduate Access Program will automatically be considered by their graduate school. For information on the Graduate Access Program visit: www.futurestudents.unimelb.edu.au/grad/gradaccess/

Maisie Fawcett Scholarships

\$5,000 one-off payment in the first year of enrolment

Number: up to 5

Eligible students must have completed an undergraduate degree at Victoria University (priority will be given to students enrolling immediately following undergraduate studies) and be accepted into the Graduate Access Program. See criteria categories in the Graduate Access Bursaries section above.

Eleanor and Joseph Wertheim Scholarships

\$20,000 annual allowance

Number: up to 2

Applicants must be an unmarried female, at least 25 years of age at the application closing date, an Australian citizen or hold an Australian PR or permanent humanitarian visa, a student currently enrolled full-time at the University of Melbourne (at least 37.5 points per semester), with at least 12 months needed to complete their course, able to present evidence that they receive means-tested income from Centrelink and be able to demonstrate difficult circumstances. Difficult circumstances may include disability, being a carer, having dependents.

How to Apply: Submit an application to the Melbourne Scholarships Office.
Closing Date: usually late March

Indigenous Scholarships

The Centre for Indigenous Education administers the Indigenous Scholarship Program which provides specific scholarships such as housing bursaries, book vouchers, living costs and general grants. Applicants must: be able to demonstrate that they are an indigenous person of Australia and be able to demonstrate eligibility for the requirements of the scholarship.

Number: up to 28

Students must be eligible to receive an unconditional offer of a place in an approved masters program. Check the Melbourne Scholarships website for a full list of eligible courses.

How to Apply No application is necessary. Selection is made by faculties based on academic merit
Successful students are emailed an offer at the start of semester.

Asian Development Bank – Japan Scholarships (ADB)

Annual \$15,300 living allowance, 100% tuition fees, a return economy airfare, research materials allowance and health cover

Number: up to 3

Eligible students must: be a citizen of an ADB member country, be enrolled in an approved course full-time, have at least 2 years full-time work experience, be 35 years or under by closing date, return to their country of citizenship at the end of their course.

How to Apply: No scholarship application is necessary.

Closing Date: Candidates must have received an unconditional offer of a course place by
31 August 2009 (for Sem 1 2010)
15 February 2010 (for Sem 2 2010)

Number: up to 10

Eligible students must have completed their final year of an undergraduate course at the University of Melbourne in 2009 and have applied to undertake a professional entry graduate degree in 2010.

How to Apply: No application is necessary. Selection is made by faculties based on academic merit. Successful students are emailed an offer in January 2010.

In addition, graduate coursework students must have completed 50 points of their current course.	How to Apply: Students must submit an application for exchange/study abroad to their student centre to be automatically considered for this scholarship. Closing Dates: 31 Mar 2010 (for travel May-October 2010) 31 Aug 2010 (for travel Nov 2010-Apr 2011)

All Round 1 Financial Assistance applicants will be considered for the Aitchison Travelling Scholarship (one scholarship is awarded based on financial need with consideration given to academic merit.
