→ **Eligibility:** The Joseph and Eleanor Wertheim Scholarship is available to

unmarried female students over the age of twenty-five who:

- will be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate, graduate coursework or graduate research course at the University of Melbourne; and
- can demonstrate that they are experiencing difficult circumstances. Difficult circumstances may include for example, disability, being a carer, having dependents; and
- have at least twelve months remaining in their current course.
